Live Streaming

Did you know that more and more social media apps are adding a livestreaming feature? Some apps like **You Now** and **Live.ly** focus on livestreaming. This allows people to send real time video to a large audience over the Internet. This leaves children at higher risks of seeing unsuitable images and of being encouraged to share private images because they do not believe that the images can be recorded by screen capture software.
